Early Reading

- A child who enters Reception at the age of 4 if they have heard 2 books a day from birth will have been exposed to 2920 books!
- 60% of 7-14 year olds with behaviour issues due to language impairment
- 2008 - 17% of homes less than 5 books in home!

- Segmenting letters for spelling
