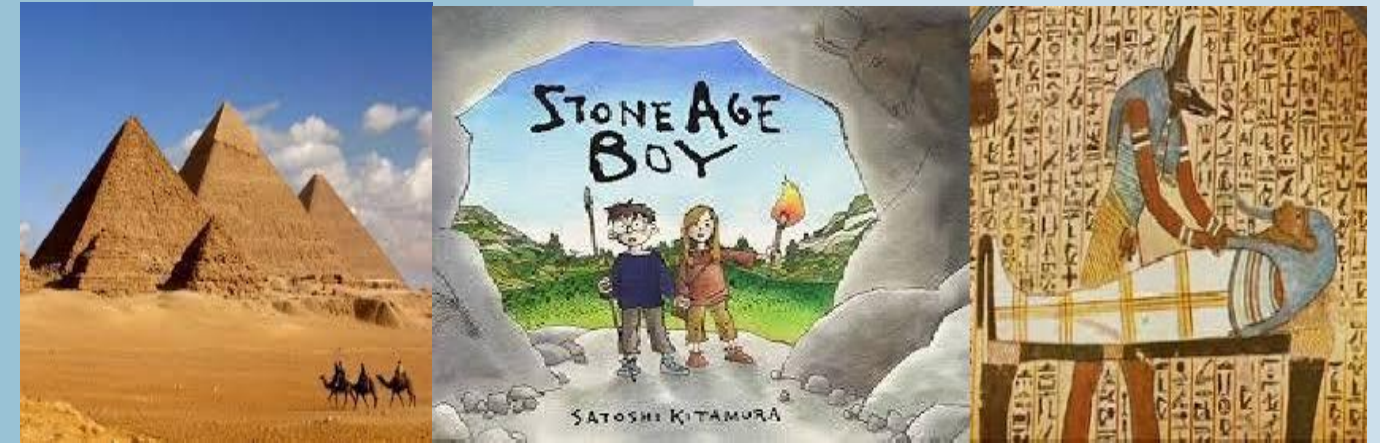


As you move through the school it is more and more important to keep organised to make the most of learning time.

Getting Organised

PE

- Children are listened to read 1:1 once in a 2-week cycle. This is in addition to daily whole class reading.

- Children should read daily, practise their spellings and access online learning tools such as TT Rockstars, Bug Club, Spelling frame and Mathletics
