**11:45—12:00**—Story, Song and Prayer time

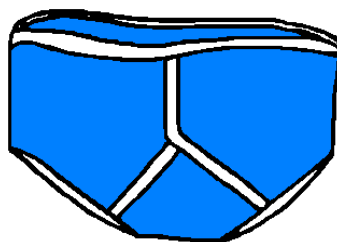
When you come to school on your first day you will find a peg with your name on just like this:
